a-ble To keep that which I've com-mit-ted Un-to Him a-gainst that day."

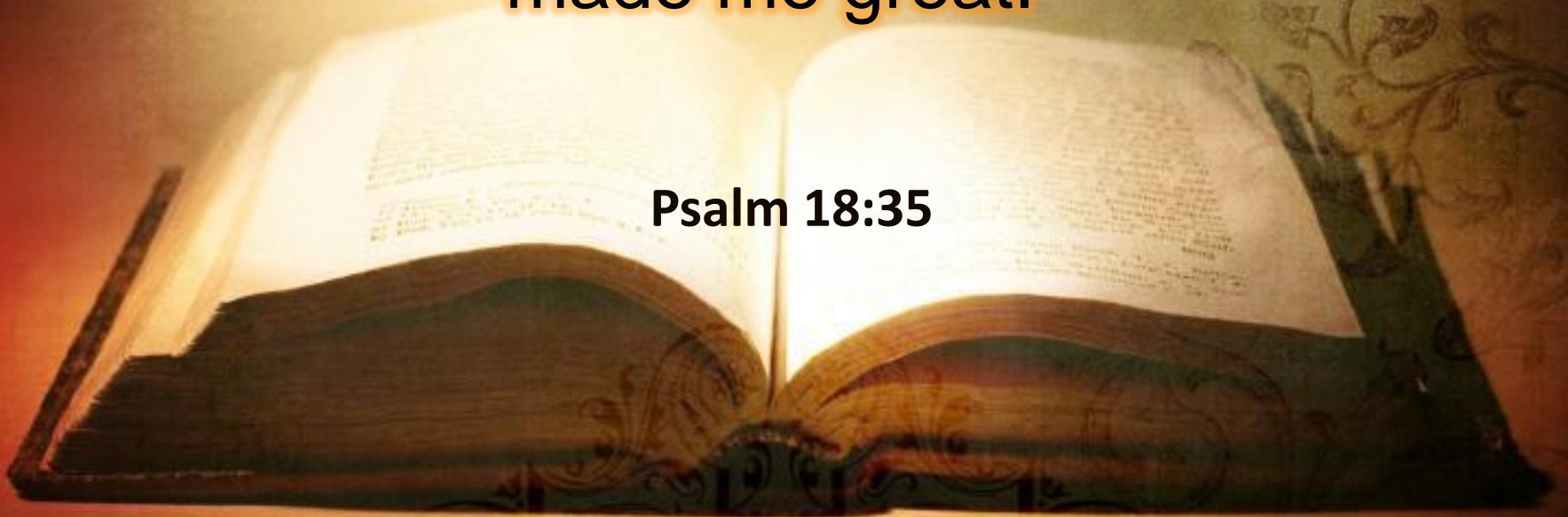
