



#### Romans 3:23 (KJV) <sup>23</sup>For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;

2 Corinthians 3:4-6 (HCSB) <sup>4</sup>We have this kind of confidence toward God through Christ. <sup>5</sup> |It is | not that we are competent in ourselves to consider anything as coming from ourselves, but our competence is from God. <sup>6</sup> He has made us competent to be ministers of a new covenant, not of the letter, but of the Spirit. 


