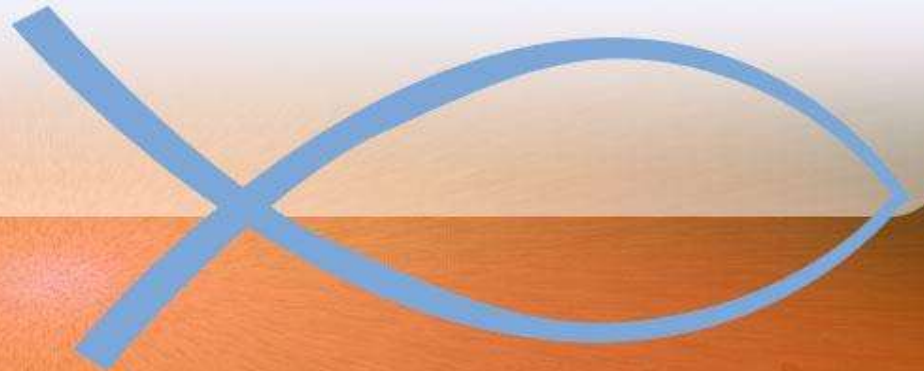
## **2 Timothy 3:1-2**

## Exodus 15

<sup>2</sup> So Moses brought Israel from the Red Sea; then they went out into the Wilderness of Shur. And they went three days in the wilderness and found no water. <sup>23</sup> Now when they came to Marah, they could not drink the waters of Marah, for they *were* bitter. Therefore the name of it was called Marah.<sup>[a]</sup> <sup>24</sup> And the people complained against Moses, saying, “What shall we drink?”

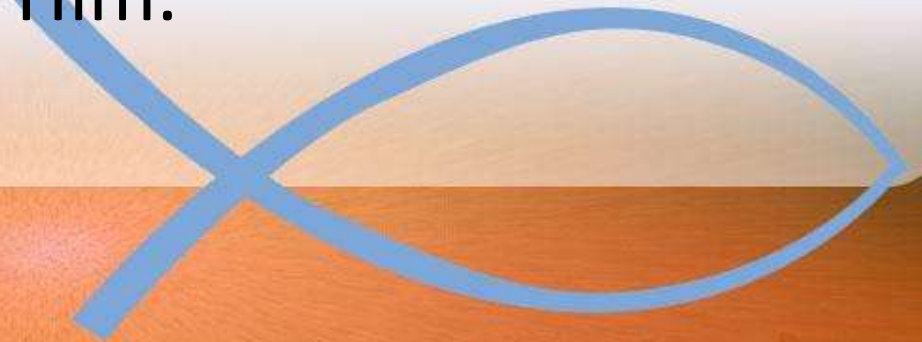
## 1 Corinthians 10:5

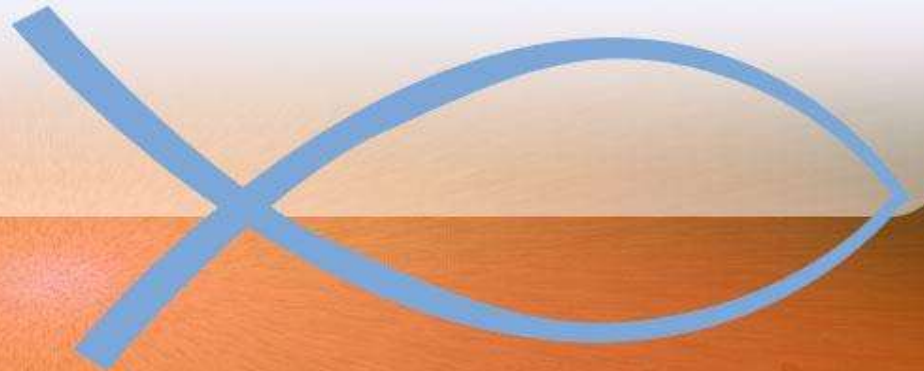

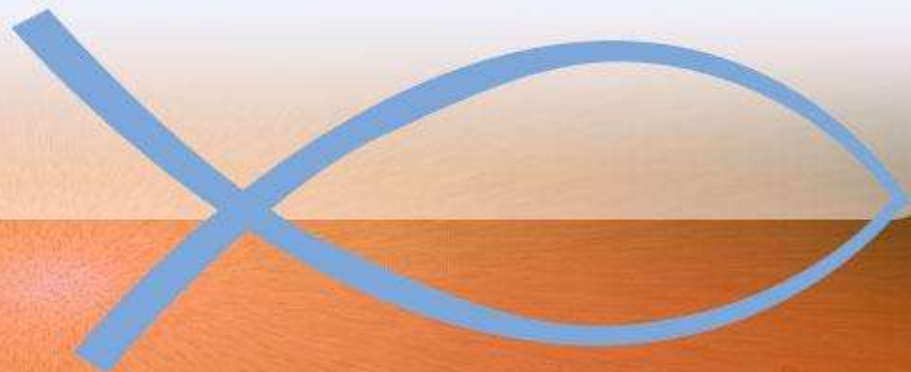
