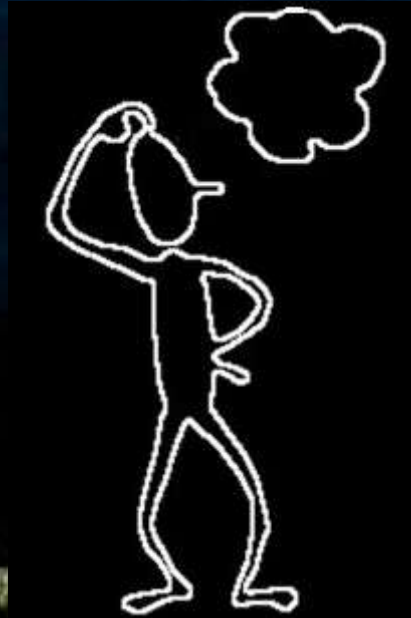

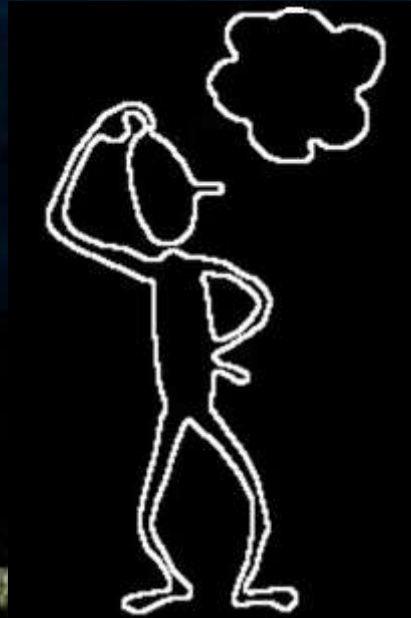
2. The Nemesis of Forgetfulness
