





²⁴ For we were saved in this unseen hope, for hope that is seen is not hope; for why does one still hope for what he sees? ² But if we hope for what we do not see, we eagerly wait for it with perseverance. ²⁶ Likewise the Spirit also helps in our weaknesses. 
Romans 8:24-36

Turn to Jesus!




He won't turn you away.




