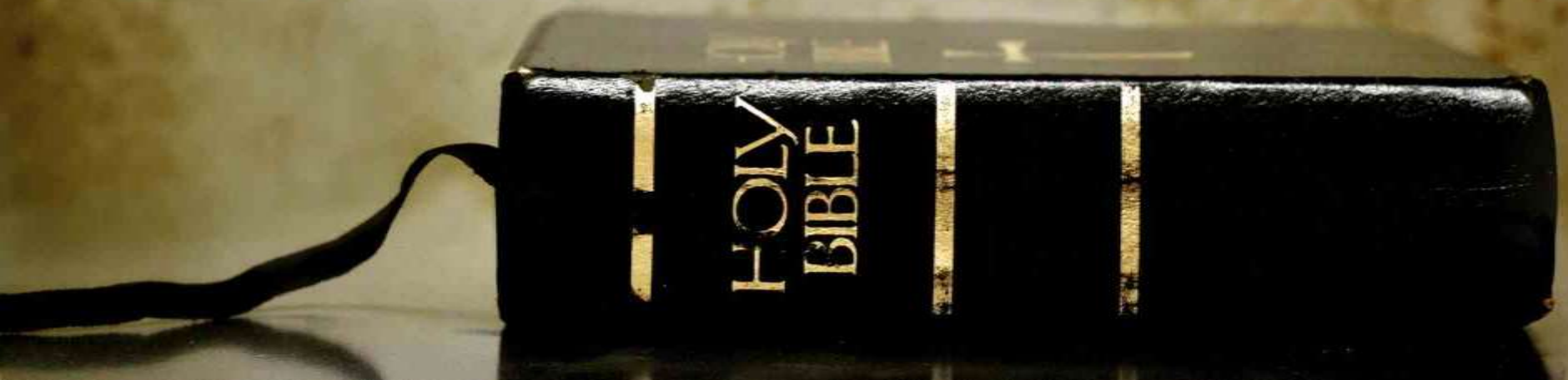


**Num 23:19 God is not a man, that he should lie, nor a son of man, that he should change his mind. Does he speak and then not act? Does he promise and not fulfill?**

# Biblical Belief

- Romans 10:10 tells us “...*with the heart man believes...*” The word “believe” in scripture is the Greek word “**pisteuo**”. The root of this word means **to trust**.


