TO UNDERSTAND WHY THE NAMES LISTED ARE DIFFERENT, ONE SHOULD FIND A GOOD BIBLE DICTIONARY, AND SEARCH FOR GENEALOGY, THE EXPLANATION IS TO INVOLVED TO INCLUDE ON THIS CHART. HOWEVER, FOR THE GENERATIONS OF FAITH STUDY, THE NAMES ON THIS CHART WILL HELP US TO GAIN A CLEARER PERSPECTIVE WHEN WE LOOK AT THE INFORMATION ON THE OTHER CHARTS.

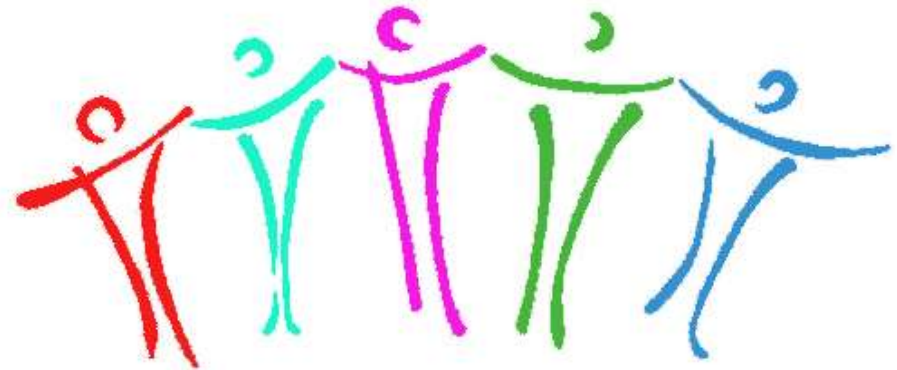
### 3. My Story

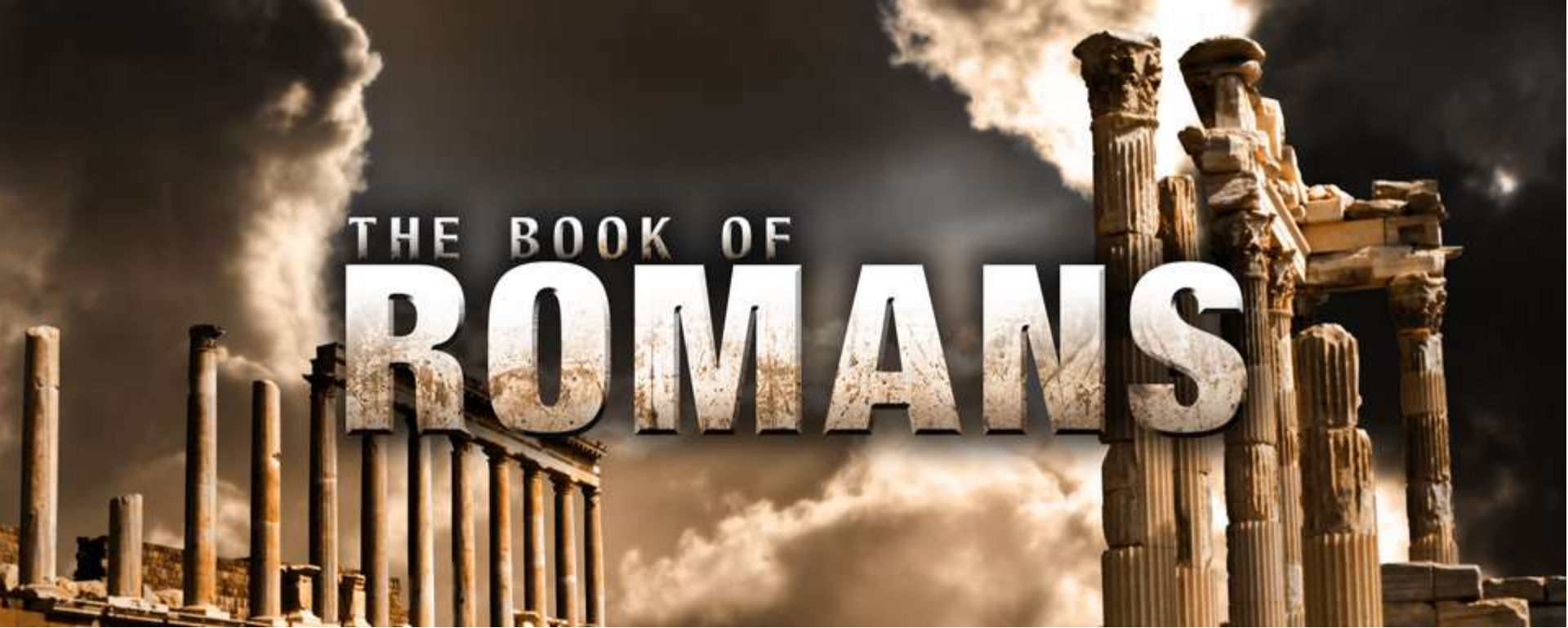
