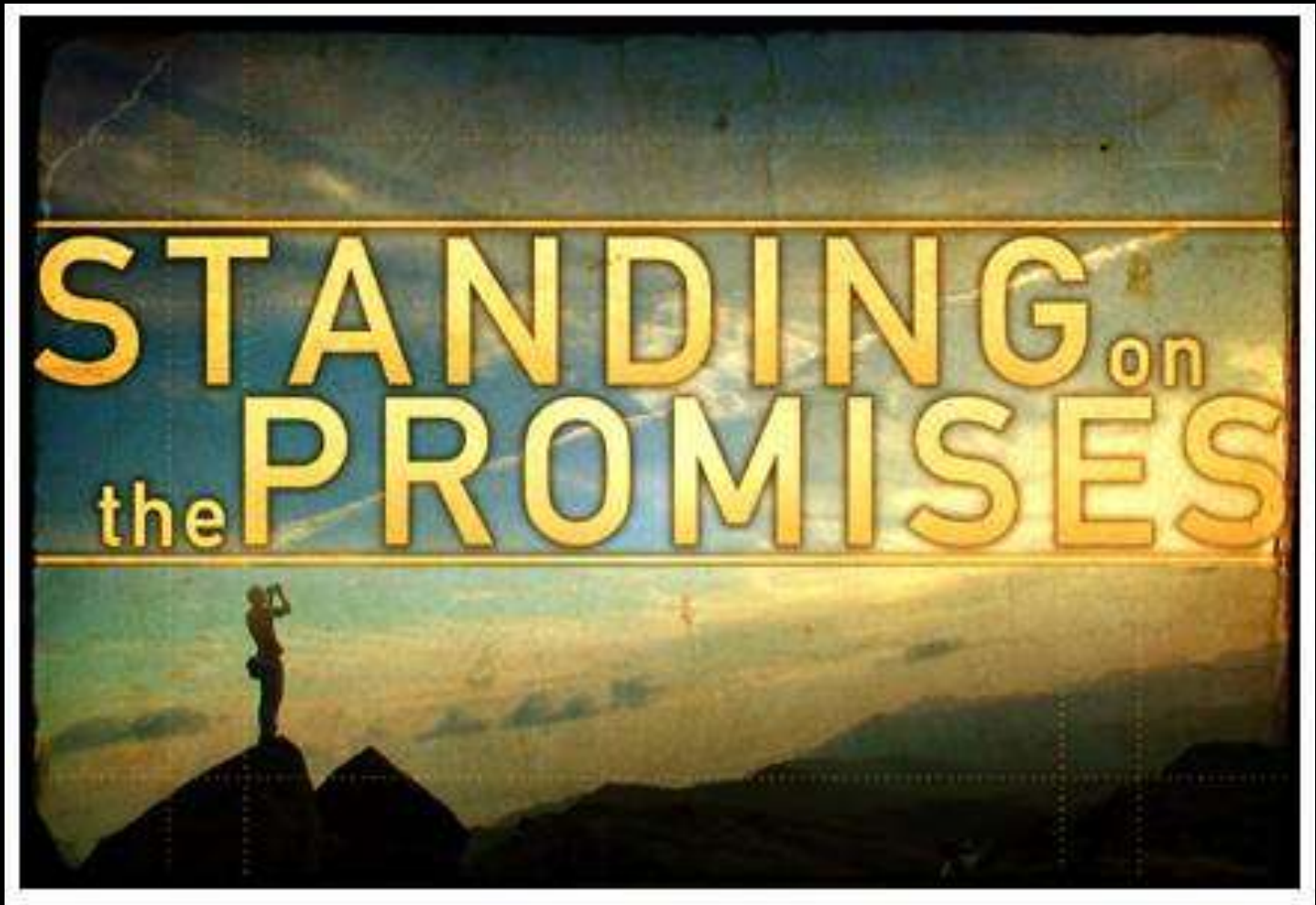

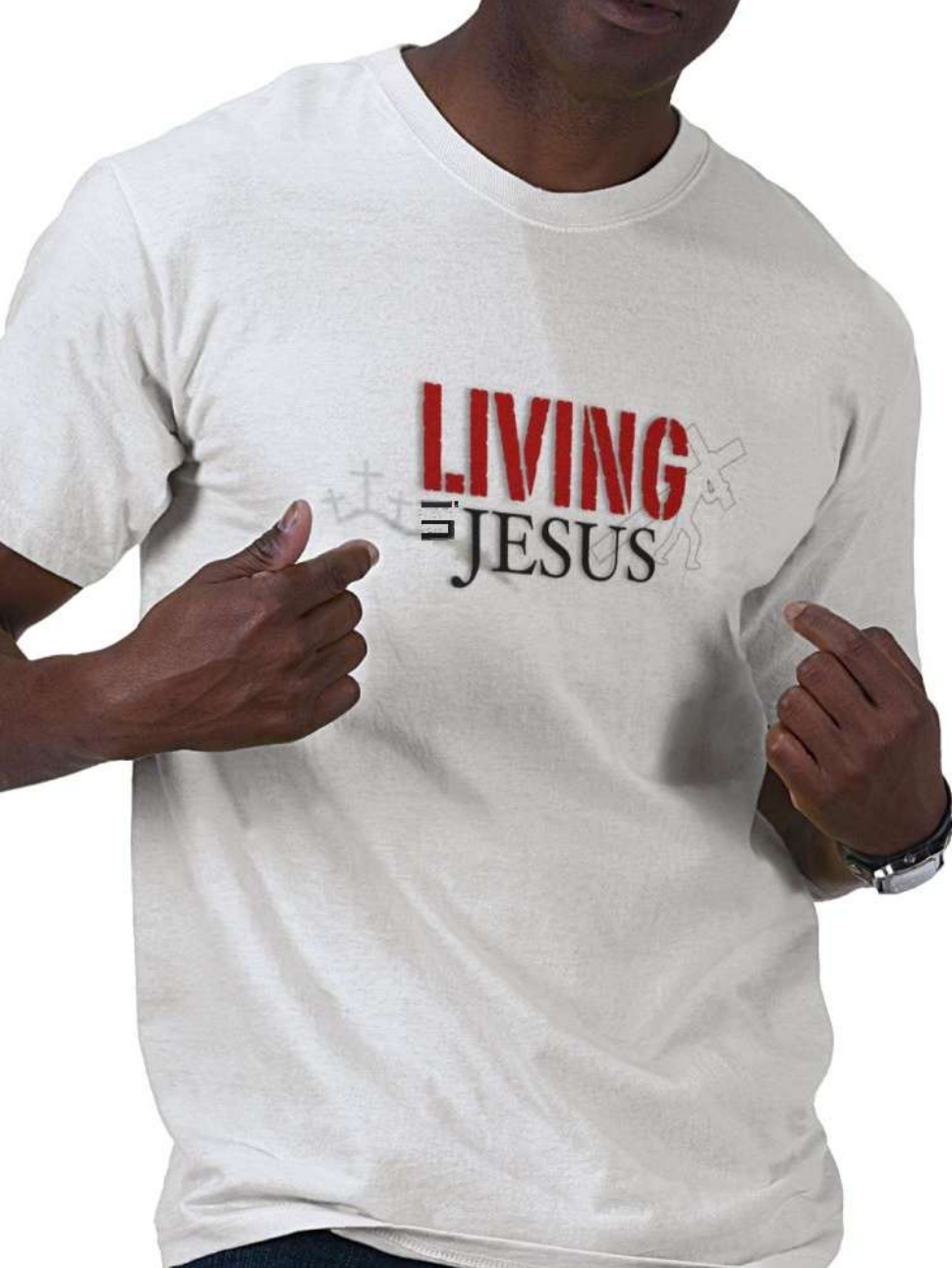
PROMISES

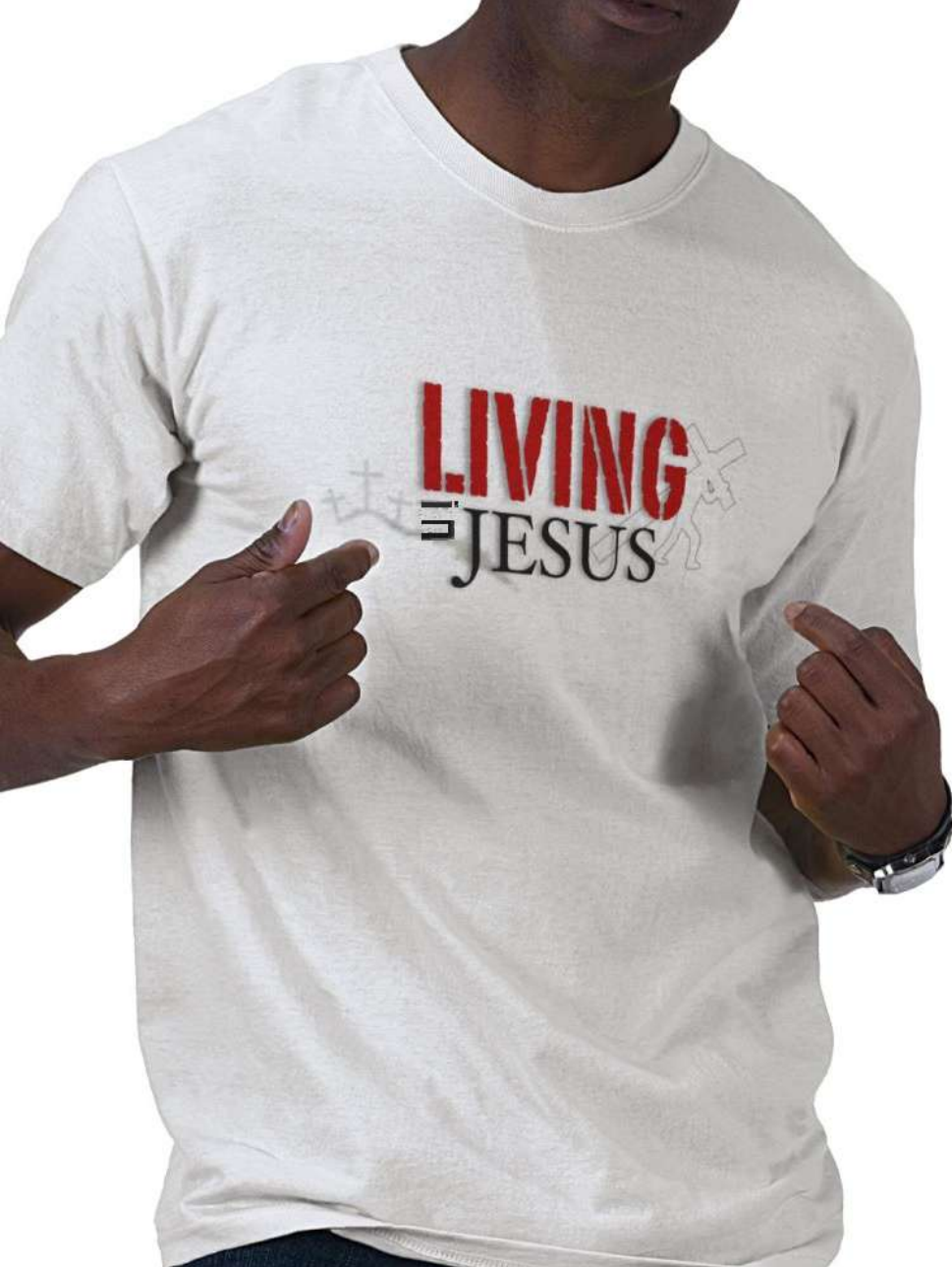
HEBREWS 6:17-20

PROMISES

Because God wanted to show His unchangeable purpose even more clearly to the heirs of the promise, He guaranteed it with an oath, 18 so that through two unchangeable things, in which it is impossible for God to lie, we who have fled for refuge might have strong encouragement to seize the hope set before us. 19 We have this [hope] as an anchor for our lives, safe and secure. It enters the inner sanctuary behind the curtain. 20 Jesus has entered there on our behalf as a forerunner, because He has become a high priest forever in the order of Melchizedek.

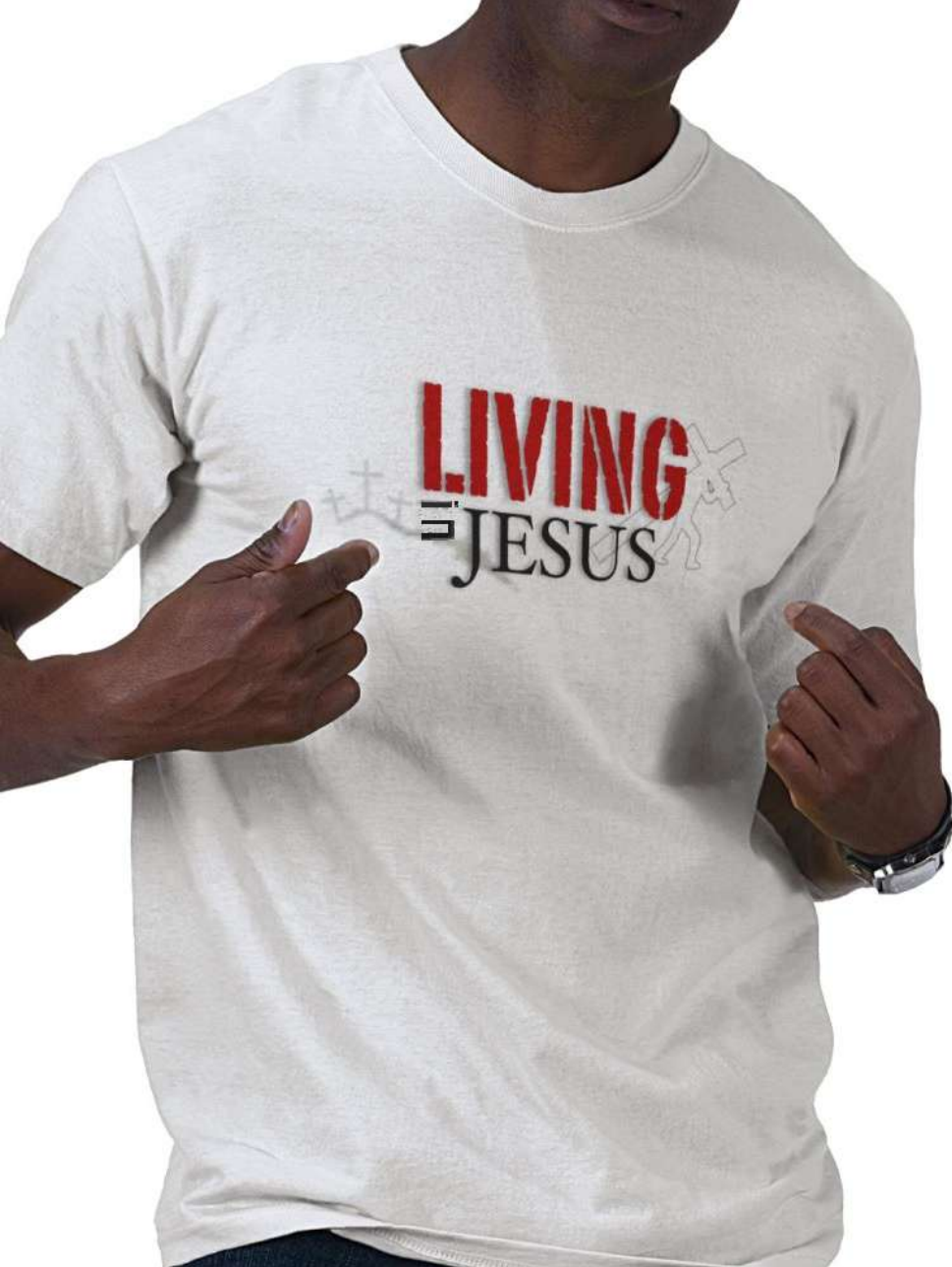

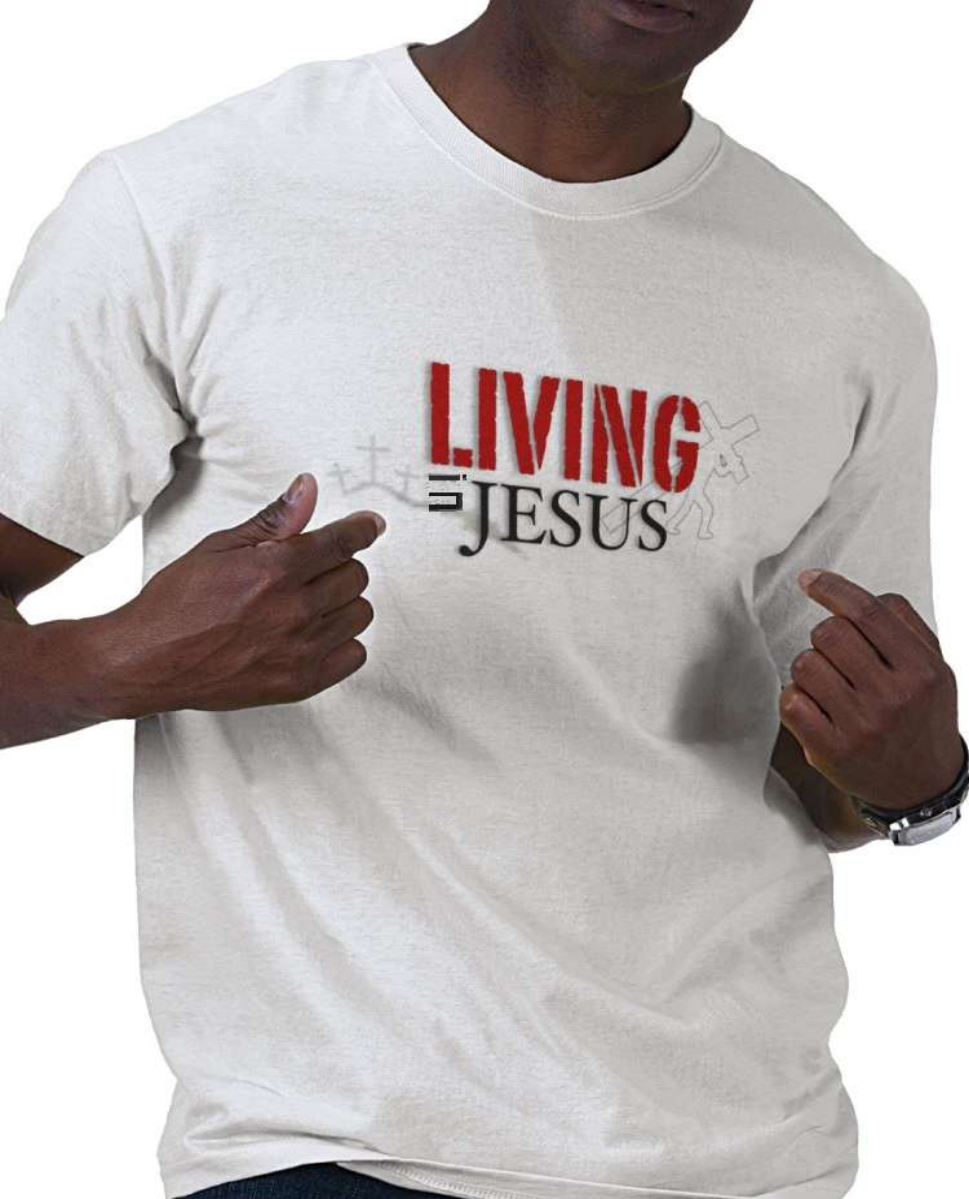

A little "i" and a lot less of "me"



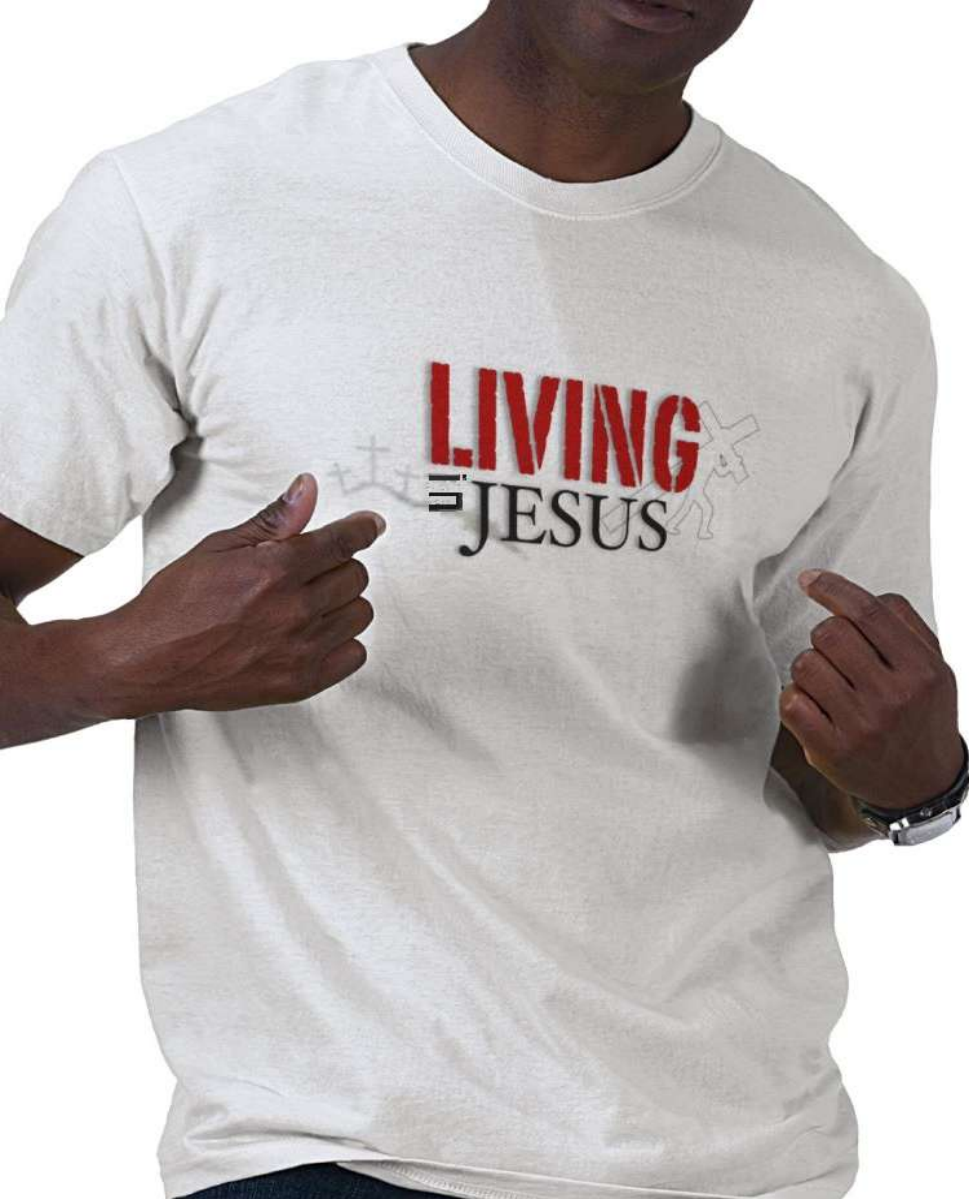
1 John 4:4

Little “i” and little “me”

i” have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer “i” who live, but Christ lives in and through me; and the life which “i” now lives in the flesh “i” lives by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me” (Gal 2:20).
