


Matthew 19:16-22

Matthew 19:16-17 (NKJV)



Leviticus 18:5 (NKJV) You shall therefore keep My statutes and My judgments, which if a man does, he shall live by them: I am the Lord.

Leviticus 18:5 (HCSB) Keep My statutes and ordinances; a person will live if he does them. I am Yahweh.






John 15:5 (NKJV)

²⁶But Jesus looked at *them* and said to them, "With men this is impossible, but with God all things are possible."




Leviticus 18-19



Leviticus 19:2 (NKJV)

Exodus 19:6 (NKJV)

And you shall be to Me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation.' These are the words which you shall speak to the children of Israel."

Leviticus 19:2 (NKJV)

"Speak to all the congregation of the children of Israel, and say to them: 'You shall be holy, for I the Lord your God am holy.



2 Corinthians 6:16 (NKJV)

"I will live with them and walk among them, and I will be their God, and they will be my people."




"The Bible says that God is holy, holy, holy. Not that He is merely holy, or even holy, holy. He is holy, holy, holy. The Bible never says that God is love, love, love, or mercy, mercy, mercy, or wrath, wrath, or justice, justice, justice. It does say that He is holy, holy, the whole earth is full of His glory.

The primary meaning of holy is 'separate.' It comes from an ancient word that meant, 'to cut,' or 'to separate.' Perhaps even more accurate would be the phrase 'a cut above something.' When we find a garment or another piece of merchandise that is outstanding, that has a superior excellence, we use the expression that it is 'a cut above the rest.

This means that the one who is holy is uniquely holy, with no rivals or competition.



"When the Bible calls God holy it means primarily that God is transcendentally separate. He is so far above and beyond us that He would be totally foreign to us except that he made himself relatable to us. To be holy is to be 'other,' to be different in a special way.
