How Does David React?

1 Samuel 17

Then David said to Saul, "Let no man's heart fail because of him; your servant will go and fight with this Philistine."





And all the men of Israel, when they saw the man, fled from him and were dreadfully afraid.





SLAYERS

1. David <u>cared</u> about what others said about the God of Israel.

And David <u>believed</u> that God would stand with him when he stood up against those who opposed God. Just as Jesus confronted even the religious leaders when they opposed God.

SLAYERS

Secondly, David thought more of others then of self. If you'll note his response to Saul, David said, "Don't let anyone be discouraged by him; your servant will go and fight this Philistine!"

Don't just look out for your own interests, also be concerned about the interests of others. (PHP 2:4)













Discouragement



David does not let the skepticism and criticism of others undermine his confidence in God.

Your servant has been a faithful shepherd watching over his father's sheep and when a lion or a bear came and took a lamb out of the flock he didn't just stand back and watch like a hired hand. No, he knew what his father expected of him, and he went after the thief and knocked it to the ground, and rescued the lamb from its mouth, and if the animal rose up, and turned on him, he'd kill it.
