

Peter answered and said, "The Christ of God." <sup>21</sup> And He strictly warned and commanded them to tell this to no one, <sup>22</sup> saying, "The Son of Man must suffer many things, and be rejected by the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and be raised the third day."**

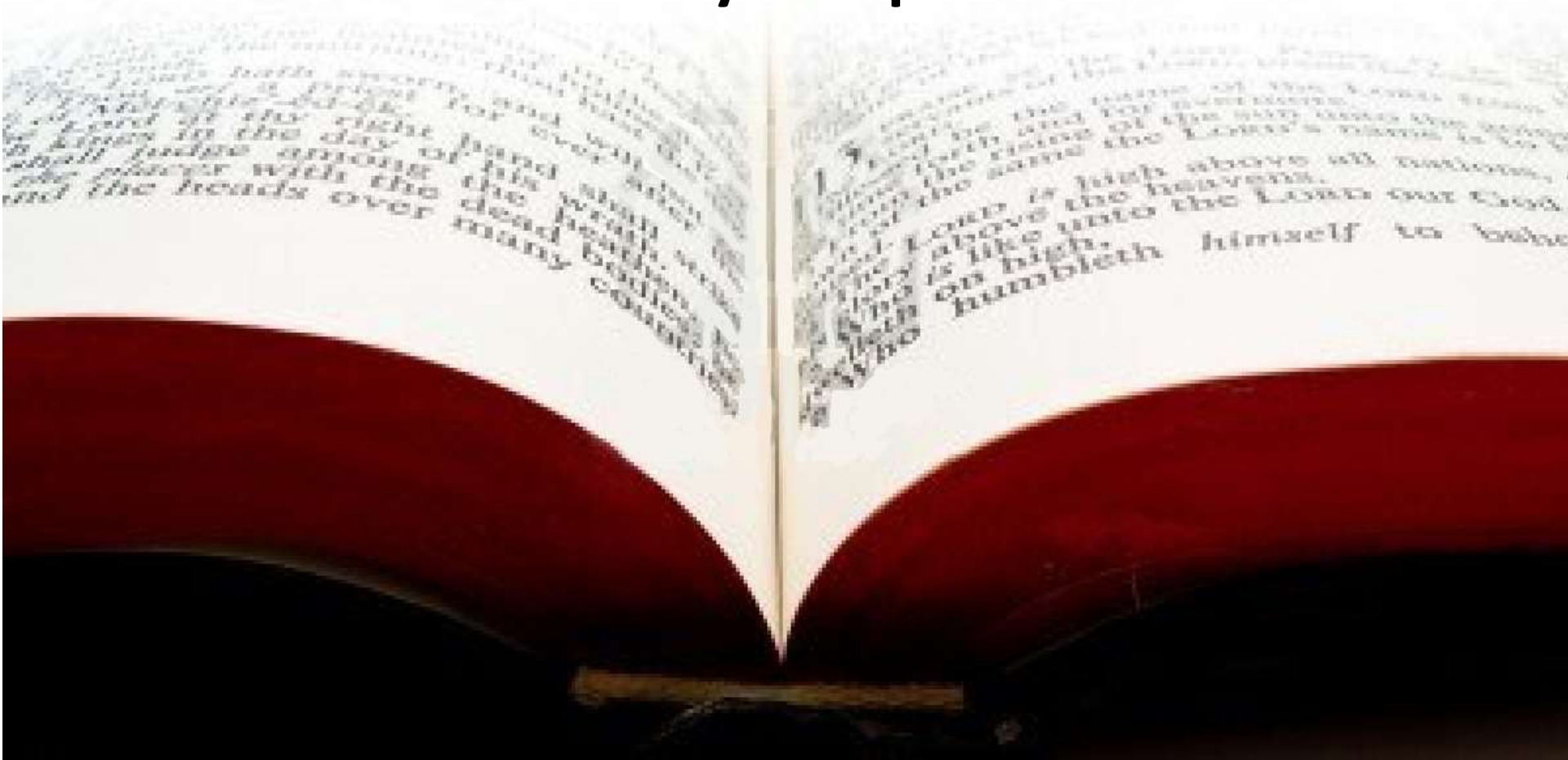
## Luke 9:23 (NKJV)

**“You are blessed when they insult and persecute you and falsely say every kind of evil against you because of Me.**

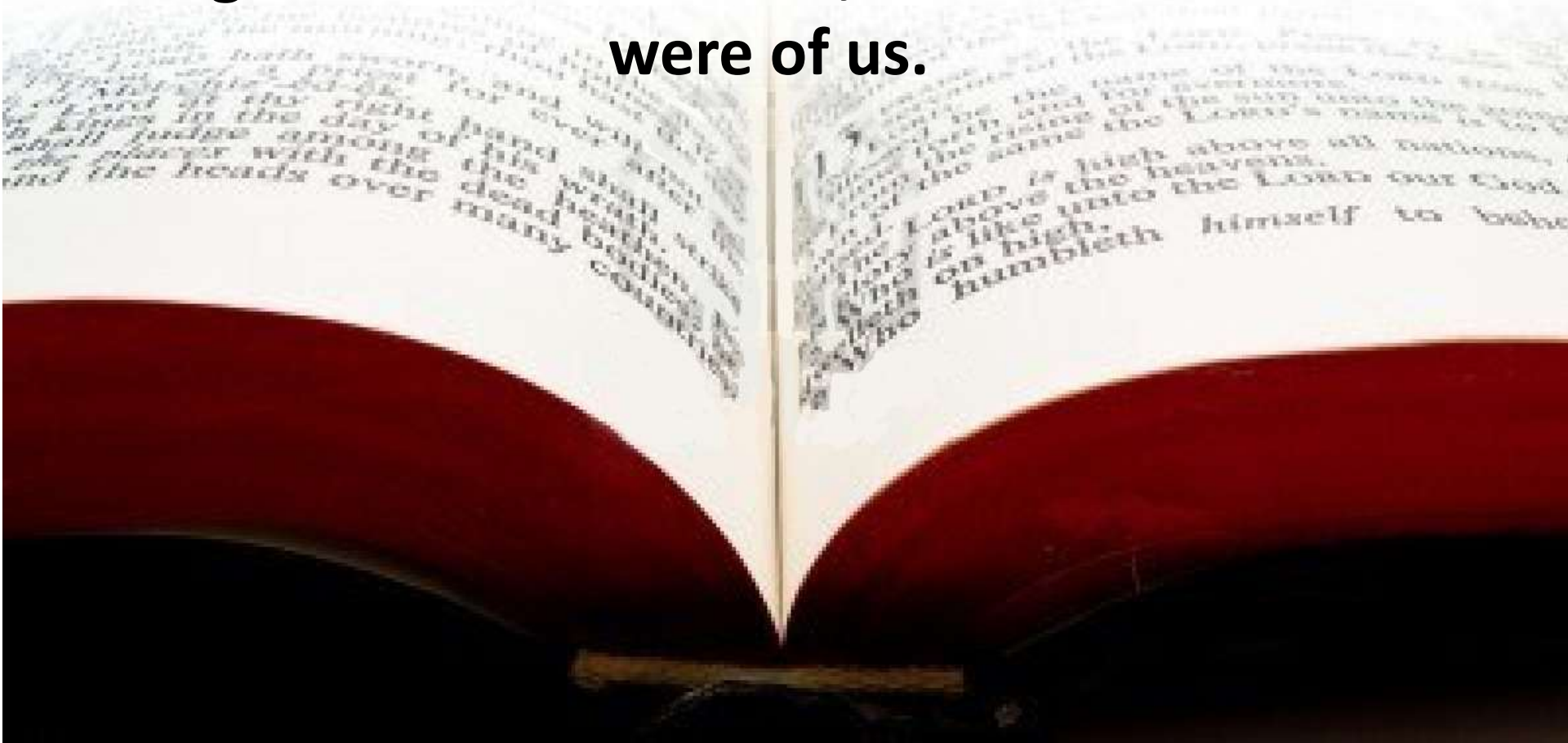

They went out from us, but they were not of us; for if they had been of us, they would have continued with us; but *they went out* that they might be made manifest, that none of them were of us.







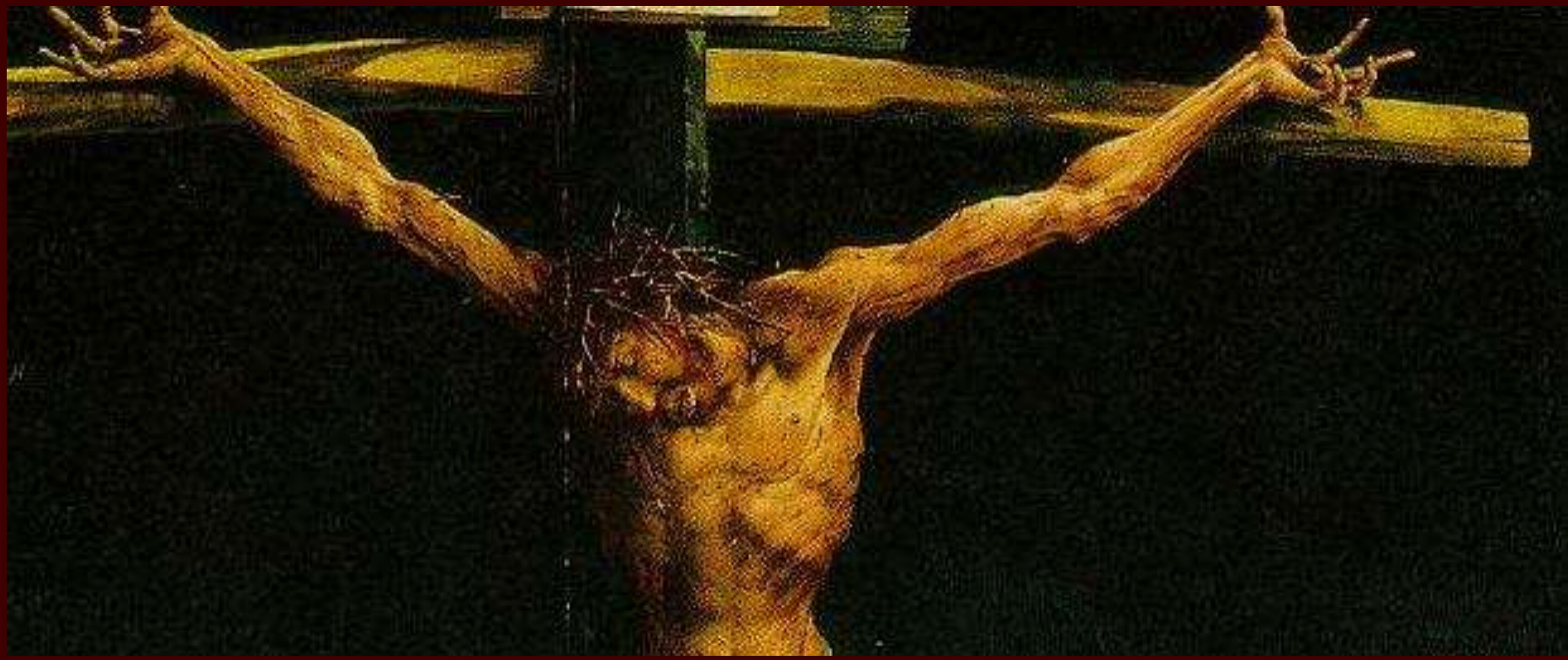

**Matthew 10:39 (NKJV)**

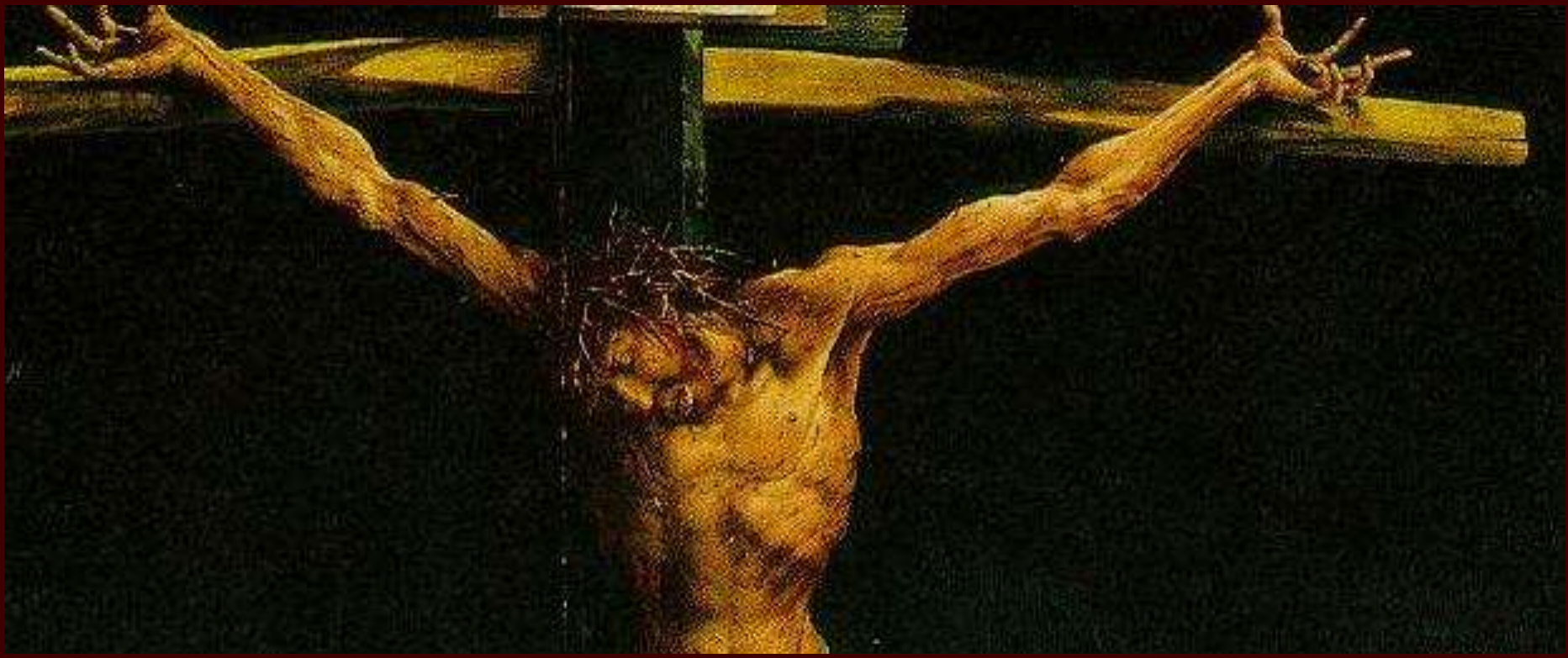
**He who finds his life will lose it,

**Don’t “sell out” on Him**



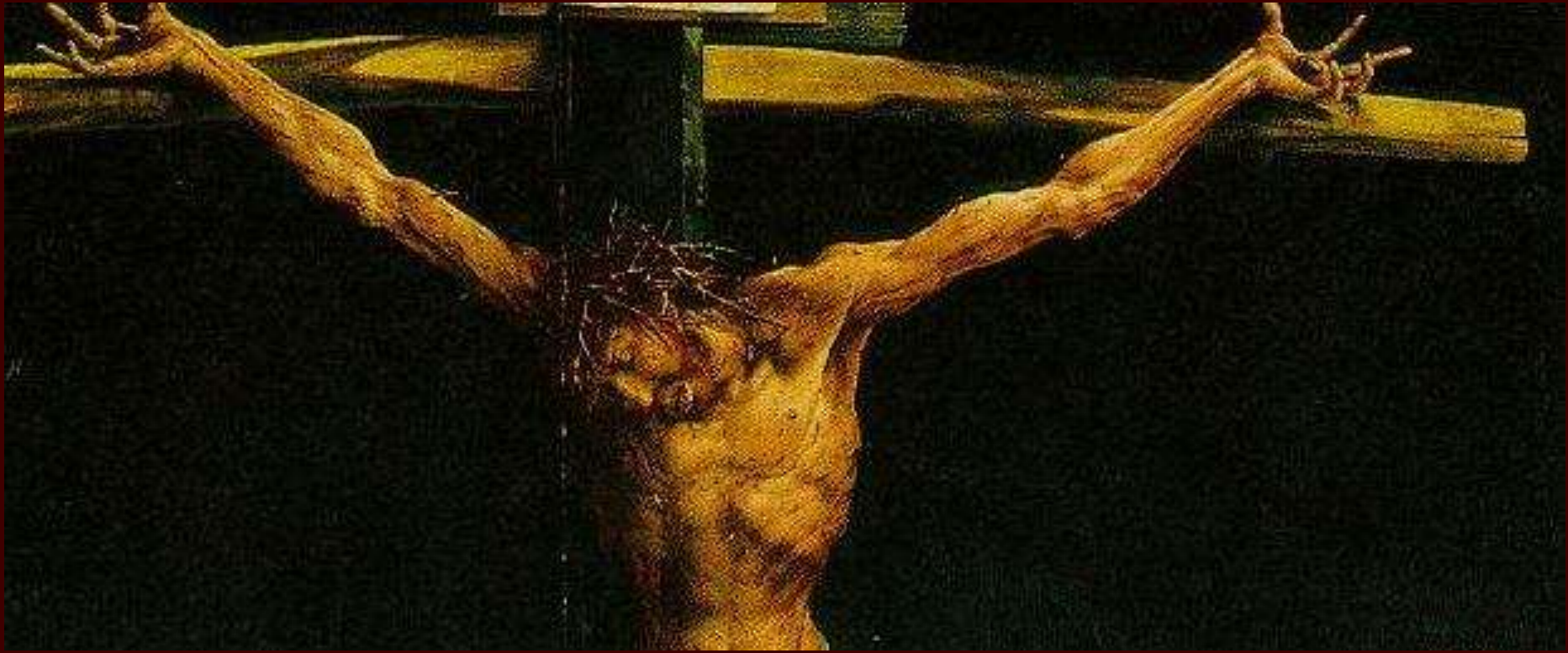
## **John 3:16 (NKJV)**
