dis-cre-tion - the freedom to decide what should be done in a particular situation or who to hang around and who not to hang around.


par·ti·al·i·ty - unfair bias in favor of one thing or person compared with another; favoritism.







### Warren Wiersbe

"God used this century old regulation about food to teach Peter a spiritual lesson.

Because the distinction between 'clean and unclean foods' was a major problem between the Jews and the Gentiles in that day. In fact, Peter's Christian friends criticized him for eating with the Gentiles."

And think about it, if a Jew could not eat with a Gentile, they probably couldn't be friends. One of the signs you are a friend with someone is that you eat together. This division in food, really pointed to a division amongst people. Wiersbe adds, "God was not simply changing Peter's diet; He was changing his entire program! The Jew was not 'clean' and the Gentile unclean both Jew and Gentile were unclean before God."
