

¹⁶ For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son,




Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. For all that is in the world--the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life--is not of the Father but is of the world. And the world is passing away, and the lust of it; but he who does the will of God abides forever.

The Bible uses "world" in three different senses:

1. It can refer to the physical world that is in this universe (Matthew 16:26; John 13:1).



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- 1. It can refer to the physical world that is in this universe (Matthew 16:26; John 13:1).
- 2. It can refer to the people who reside in this world (John 3:16).
- 3. It can refer to those who are focused on this present life and, therefore, are without God (I Corinthians 1:20; 3:19; Colossians 2:8).

The Bible uses "world" in three different senses:

"We know that we are of God, and the whole world lies under the sway of the wicked one"




⁴ You are of God, little children, and have overcome them, because He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world.

Self-ish-ness


NOUN

I say then: Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh.




