






a) Our Beliefs Determine Our Actions







⁶But without faith *it is* impossible to please *Him,* for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and *that* He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.






The Law of the Pendulum











Luke 6:32-34 (NKJV)


- ³²But if you love those who love you, what credit is that to you? For even **sinners** love those who love them.










BELIEVE





God the Son // Jesus Christ virgin-born, sinless, died on the cross for our sins, was raised from the dead and is coming again Matthew 1:18; Hebrews 4:15; I Corinthians 15:3-4; John 14:3

God the Spirit // The Holy Spirit, whom every believer receives, leads, guides, comforts, convicts, and gives spiritual gifts Ephesians 1:13-14. Ephesians 4:11

Sin // All people, by nature and by choice, sin Psalms 51:5, Romans 3:23

Salvation // Salvation is a free gift, purchased by Jesus, bestowed by God's grace and received by faith Ephesians 2:8-9, John 10:27-28, John 3:16, Romans 10:9

Baptism // Symbolic of Christ's death, burial and resurrection, Biblical Baptism is immersion in water of a professed believer Acts 8:36-39, Romans 6:1-4
