"He needed to go through Samaria" v. 4




### 1. He Had to Do the Unusual



John frequently used the verb dei (Vs 4, had to, needed to,) to speak of Jesus fulfilling the mission given Him by the Father (3:14; 9:4; 10:16; 12:34; 20:9). He was always


(3:14; 9:4; 10:16; 12:34; 20:9). He was always conscious of doing the Father's will, which was why He came to earth (6:38 cf. 4:34; 5:30; 17:4; Matt 26:39).





As the woman looks at Jesus and He at her, four invisible walls stand between them. There is a religious wall, a gender wall, a racial wall and a moral wall. Yet our Lord found a way through all of them. He found her...and then she found Him!





Luke 19:10 tells us that the Lord Jesus came to seek and to save the lost. This story tells us what that means, what it looks like.

John 20:21, Jesus said, "as the father hath sent me, so send I you."




#### John 4:6-7 (NKJV)

given you living water."





### HE CARES ABOUT YOU!




Like the woman at the well
