
Born in Bethlehem of a virgin

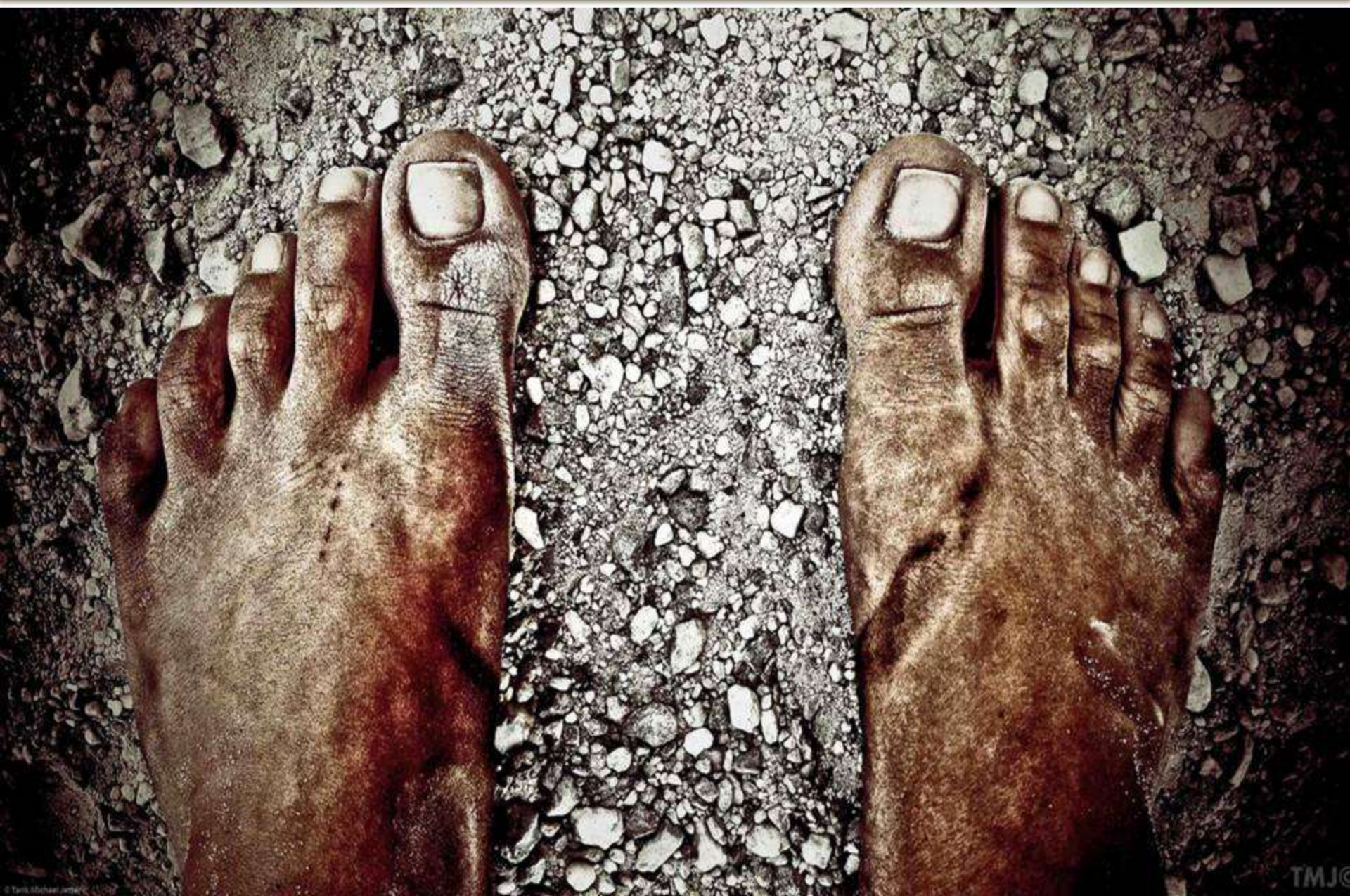

Isaiah 11:6-9 (NLT)

⁶ In that day the wolf and the lamb will live together; the leopard will lie down with the baby goat. The calf and the yearling will be safe with the lion, and a little child will lead them all.

⁷ The cow will graze near the bear. The cub and the calf will lie down together. The lion will eat hay like a cow.

Isaiah 2:4

They shall beat their swords into
plowshares and their spears into pruning hooks;
nation will not lift sword against nation and they
will no longer study warfare.

Isaiah 11:6-9

The wolf will live with the lamb, the leopard will lie down with the goat, the calf and the lion and the yearling together; and a little child will lead them. The cow will feed with the bear, their young will lie down together, and the lion will eat straw like the ox. The infant will play near the hole of the cobra, and the young child put his hand into the viper's nest. They will neither harm nor destroy on all my holy mountain, for the earth will be full of the knowledge of the Lord as the waters cover the sea.



2 Corinthians 5:19-21 (NLT)

19 For God was in Christ (in the Messiah), reconciling the world to himself, no longer counting people's sins against them. And he gave us this wonderful message of reconciliation. 20 So we are Christ's (the Messiah's) ambassadors; God is making his appeal through us (today). We speak for Christ when we plead, "Come back to God!" 21 For God made Christ, who never sinned, to be the offering for our sin, so that we could be made right with God through Christ.
