 Research shows that trusting societies are less corrupt, have lower crime rates, are more open to trade, and have higher levels of economic growth.





Research shows that trusting people are more accepting of risk. They may be more vulnerable to risky situations, but they are also in the best position to profit from taking greater risks. Mistrusting people may protect themselves by avoiding risk, but trusting people are the ones who will reap the biggest profits.





- Study after study reveals that TRUST is the basis for a civil society. It is a necessary condition for people to wholeheartedly engage in almost anything.

About 1.4 million new cases of cancer are diagnosed each year in this country, and about 570,000 Americans will die of this disease. From birth to death, men have a 43 percent chance of developing some form of cancer (including nonfatal cancers such as skin cancer), and women have a 38 percent chance.
