Rom 12:1 NIV






2. Why Worship God?

Recent studies show that the father has a profound influence on his children's moral development, self-image and sexual identity.




Kids who grow up with the presence of an engaged, caring and loving father are less likely to live in poverty, get on welfare, go to prison, and get pregnant before they get married.
