The joy I can't explain fills my heart, Since the day I made Jesus my King; His blessed Holy Spirit is leading my way, He's teaching and I'm learning to lean



Hebrews 11:24-26 (NLT)

²⁴ It was by faith that Moses, when he grew up, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter. ²⁵ He chose to share the oppression of God's people instead of enjoying the fleeting pleasures of sin. ²⁶ He thought it was better to suffer for the sake of Christ than to own the treasures of Egypt, for he was looking ahead to his great reward.

Psalm 49:1-15

¹ Hear this, all peoples; Give ear, all inhabitants of the world, ² Both low and high, Rich and poor together. ³ My mouth shall speak wisdom, And the meditation of my heart shall give understanding.⁴ I will incline my ear to a proverb; I will disclose my dark saying on the harp. ⁵ Why should I fear in the days of evil, When the iniquity at my heels surrounds me? ⁶ Those who trust in their wealth And boast in the multitude of their riches,

⁷ None of them can by any means redeem his brother, Nor give to God a ransom for him--⁸ For the redemption of their souls is costly, And it shall cease forever--⁹ That he should continue to live eternally, And not see the Pit. ¹⁰ For he sees wise men die; Likewise the fool and the senseless person perish, And leave their wealth to others. ¹¹ Their inner thought *is that* their houses will last forever, Their dwelling places to all generations; They call their lands after their own names.

¹² Nevertheless man, though in honor, does not remain; He is like the beasts that perish. ¹³ This is the way of those who are foolish, And of their posterity who approve their sayings. Selah ¹⁴ Like sheep they are laid in the grave; Death shall feed on them; The upright shall have dominion over them in the morning; And their beauty shall be consumed in the grave, far from their dwelling.¹⁵ But God will redeem my soul from the power of the grave, For He shall receive me.
