So Great is our Salvation...

...that we have **been delivered from the curse of sin which is death**. Death has lost its sting, **no longer do we need to fear death or what men might do to our bodies**, for they are unable to do anything to our soul (Mat. 10:28).

So Great is our Salvation...

...that through Christ's death on the cross **our sins have been forgiven**, covered by His blood and forgotten by God (Heb. 8:12, 10:17). We passed immediately from death to life and were **delivered forever from condemnation** (Rom. 8:1).

So Great is our Salvation...
