





When it comes to Godly Leadership **character** counts more than **competency**.











1. The "Motivation" Principle

³¹ Therefore, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God.






2. The "Humility" Principle

⁶ Therefore humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you in due time,






3. The "Faith" Principle

⁶ But without faith *it is* impossible to please *Him,* for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and *that* He is a rewarder of those who diligently






3. The "Faith" Principle

⁶ Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.






4. The "Faithfulness" Principle

²³ But whoever has doubts is condemned if he eats, because the eating is not from faith. For whatever does not proceed from faith is sin.






4. The "Courage" Principle

⁶ Be strong and courageous...






4. The "Holy Spirit" Principle
